Before, there were three tiny apartments in a row. The owner assumed that combining them would produce much the same pattern of separate rooms. Not necessarily, said **McInturff Architects**. Mark McInturff proposed using several sliding pocket doors: By shifting them around, the owners could define bedrooms and kitchen at will. ■ Permanent walls of stucco, Venetian plaster, and black marble help define the boundaries of the living areas. Opposite, the new 65-foot window wall opens to a vista of Dupont Circle. ■ "There's a level of gracious living possible in these buildings that's not immediately apparent," the judges said. **Renovations Unlimited, Inc.** of Northeast DC was the contractor.
